

**Yatton Keynell Parish Council**  
**Community Benefit Fund Report – March 2018**

The fund paid out £5,630 during the year bringing the total expenditure to date of £30,656 leaving a balance to be spent of £9,344.

The Ebenezer Chapel were awarded £5,000 to fund major repairs to the structure of the chapel.

We rented a Speed Indicator Device (SID) twice during the year at a cost of £480.

The School entrance project, expenditure was £150.
